EMPOWERING PARENTS TO IMPROVE RURAL SCHOOLING IN MEXICO

The School Improvement Program awards \$600 USD annual grants to parents' associations in 125 elementary schools located in underserved rural communities in Mexico. The project benefits 9,665 children in Chiapas, Guerrero, Puebla and Yucatán, four of most impoverished states in the country. Fondo para la Inversion the la Educacion A.C. is conducting an impact evaluation to determine the effectiveness of the Program on reducing students' grade failure and grade repetition.

This report presents the progress of the School Improvement program in the school year from September 2009 through August 2010.

Summary of main results

- The School Improvement grants have helped parents to buy school supplies and improve infrastructure and has benefited 9665 children. Our program has also improved the transparency and effectiveness in which funds are invested.
- The program appears to be successful in reducing the number of children repeating grade and in the percentage of children that are older than their corresponding school grade level. Girls are less prone to repeat grade in our schools.
- We have also observed an improvement in academic achievement as measured by standardized tests.

The program

Mexico has made a determined effort over many decades to combat poverty and reduce income inequality. Despite these efforts, children in the southern states of Mexico face enormous challenges as they struggle to advance through the education system.

Fondo para la Inversion en la Educacion A.C. has launched a program that is improving the quality of indigenous children's schooling in Mexico's rural areas by promoting parental participation.

Our program gives a \$600 grant to parent's associations. This grant is typically spent to buy school supplies, shoes, uniforms and carry out small bathrooms and classrooms renovations and represents an opportunity for parents to interact with teachers and be part of the school community.

The program also includes training workshops for parental organizations that seek to create a space for ongoing collaboration between parents and teachers. During these workshops parents draft a school improvement plan that includes how the funds will be spent and some form of in-kind collaboration from parents.

One of our objectives is to determine the effectiveness of this program on increasing parental participation in schools and reducing grade failure and grade repetition.

Population served

Schools in School Improvement program are located in rural areas with high social isolation. In our program, 115 of the 125 schools are in communities with the highest rates of poverty in the country.

They also have very high grade failure, grade repetition and drop-out rates. In our schools, 1 of every 10 students failed to pass a school year at least once.

Results to date

We present now a brief overview of the 125 schools that are part of the program and show some indicators of its impact. (See appendix A and B for a comprehensive set of tables detailing the following points.)

Our schools are considerably smaller than most schools in Mexico: they have on average 80 students per school (see table A-1). This means that many teachers in our schools work in the same classroom with children from different ages and grade levels (see table A-2).

- The program appears to be successful in reducing the number of children repeating grade. It is also interesting to note that girls are less prone than boys to repeat grade in our schools (see table A-3).
- We have also observed a slight improvement in the percentage of children that are older than their corresponding grade level meaning that less children are either repeating grade, or entering school at an older age (see table A-4).
- Three years after the beginning of our program, children score higher on standardized tests which measure their performance in the areas of Spanish and Math. Although these results cannot be totally ascribed to the implementation of our program we were able to note some improvements (see table A-5).
- The program benefited 9665 children during the School year from September 2009-June 2010 and helped parents to purchase school supplies and support school renovations.
- We have also observed an improvement in parental participation in some of our schools and in the way parents decide to use our funds. Our collaboration with parental associations has improved the transparency in which these funds are spent (see appendix B).
- We have also observed a change in the effectiveness of the program administered by the Ministry of Education. Our collaboration with the Ministry of Education has helped our program to gain more visibility and has given us the opportunity to influence how the program is implemented in other schools.
